Summary of Experience

Robert W. Klute's 30-year career in architecture and facility planning has been focused exclusively in healthcare. He has led both architectural and consulting teams in working for healthcare clients across the United States. His experience includes well over \$1 billion in healthcare construction projects and ranges from totally new facilities to expansions and renovations. His credentials include planning work in specialty areas such as cancer care, cardiac care and ambulatory surgery.
